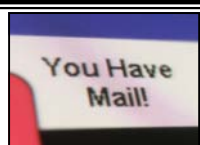

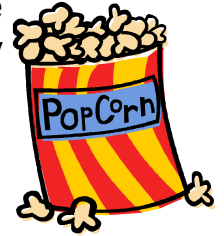
EVENING ACTIVITIES
